Just a reminder that our next meeting takes place in person on **Monday February 2nd 2026 at 7pm**, to be held at the old Unionville Train Station meeting room on Station Lane. We are pleased to confirm our guest speakers will be from the Unionville BIA (Business Improvement Association) who will provide the latest updates about the major events planned by the UBIA, now that the Main Street modifications have finished! Please review our [Letter to City staff](#) in support of the BIA's request for funding to enable Main Street summer closures and other events. Councillor McAlpine will provide Councillor updates.

We would like to introduce Bosco He and Jack Ng as new Directors of URA. Following their application and our screening process, they were appointed as Directors by the Board of Directors on January 9, 2026 in accordance with Article IV Clause 3 of the URA Constitution.

We will also be voting on another small change to our Constitution. In order to reflect available insurance policies, we propose to remove "*and his or her heirs, executors and administrations, and estate, respectively,*" from the current Article V. Indemnification of Directors, which is shown below;

"Every Director and Table Officer and his or her heirs, executors and administrations, and estate, respectively, shall from time to time and at all times, be indemnified and saved harmless, out of the funds of the URA, from and against all costs, charges and expenses whatsoever which the Director or Table Officer sustains or incurs in or about any action, suit or proceeding which is brought, commenced or prosecuted against him or her for or in respect of any act, deed, matter or thing whatsoever made, done or permitted by him or her in or about the execution of the duties of his or her office. The Board will review and approve the purchase of Directors and Officers Liability Insurance to cover these risks as much as is economically possible from our fees."

Also, notice of an upcoming meeting at City Hall on February 10, 2026 at 7:00 pm. The City of Markham is undertaking a City-wide Zoning By-law Amendment (File PR 26 108710) to update the Parking and Transportation Demand Management standards, as part of the Housing Accelerator Fund Action Plan and Citywide Parking Strategy.
